The Navigator Practitioner will join a YouthLinks Team consisting of 20 dedicated Youth Workers. YouthLinks is a place where young people between the ages of 12 to 25 are always welcome. We offer help, support and advice with education and employment pathways, career guidance, youth housing, homework tutoring, driving lessons, emergency relief, school holidays and youth leadership programs, referrals to financial counselling, Centrelink and other agencies.

The Navigator program is funded by Department of Education and supports young people aged 12 to 17 years who have less than 30% attendance at school at the previous 2 terms. The program has been successfully engaging youth with learning pathways for the last 5 years by using outreach case management, strength-based approach, and restorative practice.
